

## Stormwater Management Plan Workshop Pre-Work

The attached worksheets are for you to use to gather information on your local MS4 before you come to the workshop. If you have an existing SWMP then compare the separate worksheets to the relevant portions of your plan. If not, then these sheets are a good place to start. We will discuss the introduction (statement of local conditions) and the conclusion (tying it all together to make a functioning SWMP) at the meeting. Before you begin you might want to review the General Permit, any TMDLs on your receiving streams, and the 303 (d) list for local stream conditions. Your Pollutants of Concern (POCs) will those listed in those reports and should be the focus of your efforts. The websites for those reports are included on the Informative Links page in this attachment.

If you are not an MS4, please take one of the following approaches to completing the pre-workshop exercises:

- complete them as though you are an MS4 or represent an actual MS4, such as Jefferson Parish or St. Tammany Parish.
- complete them as though you are an advisor/consultant to an actual MS4
- complete them academically by answering the questions with what the main issue or point of the question is
